Why create an iStream account?

If you belong to a college that has purchased an institutional subscription, you will need to create your own account to access the resources and tools in iStream. When you create your account, the login information is based on your institutional email address and a password of your choosing. To get started, click on the Create Your iStream Account button above and check the drop-down institution listing to see if your college is an iStream subscriber. If it is, complete the quick form and click Submit.

If you purchased an individual, small group, or partner subscription, you were given your user name and password when you paid. If you are having trouble logging in, or cannot find this information, contact [Cheri Jessup](#) for assistance.
