Prior to joining NAU's RGC team, Dr. Mathis was senior lecturer at The University of Texas at Austin, and served as Associate Director, advisor and coach for UT's involvement in Achieving the Dream: Community Colleges Count and SENSE – the Center for Community College Student Engagement's Survey of Entering Student Engagement. Her experience as a senior administrator in higher education, national association management and international development includes professional positions with the League for Innovation in the Community College, the Institute for Supply Management, Thunderbird's School of Global Management, the Governor's Community Policy Office (AZ), the office of U.S. Senator John McCain, and the Committee on Ways and Means, U.S. House of Representatives.

Evan Alex Clausen was originally hired as a Graduate Advisor and was promoted to the Assistant Dean for Master's Faculty position, which coordinates the administration of NAU's open access master's academic programs in a manner that recognizes the integral role of faculty in promoting student learning, engagement, retention, degree completion, and maintains the highest standards of academic excellence and integrity. Alex has over 12 years of academic advisor (in which she received several awards for her retention efforts), and Dean of Students. She is a long-serving online instructor and was also nominated as a faculty of the year.

Cristina McKee has served in several roles at the RGC. Originally hired as a Financial Services Representative (FSR), she was promoted to Lead FSR, and then transitioned to her current role of Graduate Advisor, working directly with master's students to coordinate retention efforts and student success initiatives. She also was elected as Vice President and now President of the Culture Club, which is a NAU campus volunteer organization to promote NAU's core values, create an atmosphere of fun at work, foster a collaborative graduate center culture, and open lines of communication.




