

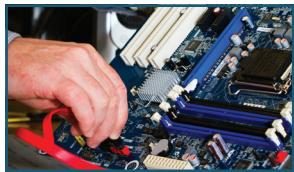


STEM CAREER CONNECTION

Together with the League for Innovation and the Walmart Brighter Futures 2.0 Project, CPCC offers STEM Career Connection training tracks designed to equip you with the employment skills needed for a career in the high-demand industry of IT.

Through our STEM Career Connection training tracks, you will receive a **national certification** to help you on your way to a career in this exciting field. Choose from the following tracks:



PC Pro/CompTIA A+ Certification: Learn the skills needed to start a career in IT. You'll study essential IT tasks such as installation, configuration, diagnostics, preventative maintenance, basic networking and security. You'll also learn customer service and the communication skills needed to work with clients.



Cisco Certified Entry Networking Technician (CCENT) Certification: Learn the skills needed for an entry-level career in networking. You'll cover how the Internet works, and how to maintain devices that support Internet and local connectivity.

In addition to receiving quality training, you will also:

- receive a voucher to cover the exam cost for a national certification.
- have access to CPCC's many support services to help you be successful on your academic journey.
- receive job placement assistance.
