## FAQs

**Q: What is the “Walmart Brighter Futures 2.0 Program”?**

**A:** It is a program designed to provide comprehensive support services to persons desiring to upgrade their employability to be positioned for better career opportunities.

**Q: What is offered in the program?**

**A:** Program components include: (can receive one or more)

- ✓ One-on-One Career Coaching
- ✓ Job Readiness Workshops
- ✓ Career Development Assessment
- ✓ Training (limited slots)
- ✓ Job Fairs and Job Placement Assistance
- ✓ Connection to Employers
- ✓ Wrap Around Supports (assistance with clearing up criminal history, veteran assistance, tax preparation, customer service training, tax preparation)

**Q: What if I am underemployed or recently laid-off or unemployed? What can you do for me?**

**A:** Tri-C has an excellent choice of career path opportunities. The WBF 2.0 Program was designed with you in mind! Also, we have Fast Track programs that prepare you for in-demand careers (employers that are ready to hire ASAP!).

**Q: What if I have a criminal history? Do I have any options?**

**A: Yes!** We have partner agencies that specialize in help with your criminal history, and assist you with realistic career opportunities. Don't let that be your reason for not pursuing a career.

**Q: I am currently in a GED/ABLE program. Do I have any options?**

**A:** We have special options for those in Tri-C GED/ABLE programs.

**Q: What if I am already in one of those Career Training Programs?**

**A:** Not a problem. That just means you really know a really good bargain when you see it! If you desire to take advantage of the supportive services of the WBF 2.0 program, we can enroll you as long as you are eligible.

**Q: How can I know if I am eligible?**

**A:** Minimum eligibility is a household income of less than \$3,333 a month, or \$40,000 a year. (proof of income: pay stubs, income tax forms, employer letter, unemployment documentation)
