#### **Qualifications**

- · You must be at least 18 years of age or older
- · You must attend a Walmart information session.
- Your income level cannot exceed the 2014 Federal 150% Annual Poverty Level.
- · You must be eligible to receive a Pell Grant
- Assessment tests may be required.



### How long does the program last?

Walmart Brighter Futures scheduled to end December 2015. However, as with any subsidized program, fund availability depends on program demand and participation which means that the allotted funds may not cover the scheduled duration of the program.

# What information is needed?

The following forms must be completely filled out before acceptance.

- Walmart Intake form application
- · Registration/Student Intake form
- · Texas Publication Education form
- · FAFSA document verifying funds
- · Assessment Scores

## When will I know if I have been accepted into the program?

Once we have your completed file, you will be notified within 48 to 72 business hours.
