## Frequently Asked Questions about Walmart Brighter Futures 2.0 Project

#### What is CareerSTART?

The SouthWest Skill Center's Walmart Brighter Futures Project offers a quick way to jump start your future and gets you on the right path through CareerSTART! In one semester, students ready themselves to take steps toward a new career. By successfully completing the CareerSTART program, students will earn employer-recognized credentials, develop a career and educational roadmap, and earn college credit.

#### How long is CPD104?

This program is approximately two months long.

#### What are the requirements to enter the program?

- ♦ Must be at least 18 years old
- ♦ Must need to attain a HSE diploma or already possess one or a high school diploma
- ♦ Must provide proof financial need
- ◆ Must have an 8<sup>th</sup> grade reading level and 6<sup>th</sup> grade math level based on the level of D TABE (Test for Adult Basic Education)

### Is financial aid available to cover the cost of the program?

Tuition and fees will be covered through the Walmart Brighter Futures Grant.

#### What are the attendance requirements to complete this program?

Because of the high level of class activity, attendance is mandatory. Tardiness and absences may result in withdrawal from the program.

**Program Cost:** \$243.00 plus fees

#### When and where are classes scheduled for CPD104?

CPD104 Tues/Thurs 5/26 – 7/7 6:00 pm – 8:40 pm

How many credit hours is CPD104? 3 credit hours

Can these credits be used toward a degree program that I may pursue at EMCC? Yes.

#### How many students have to register for CPD104 for it to make?

The CareerSTART enrollment goal is to create a cohort of at least 8 to 20 students.

#### Will I get job placement assistance after I complete the program?

In CPD104 you will prepare your resume and learn many job seeking skills. Student can utilize EMCC's Career and Transfer Center to practice mock interviews and get assistance with job search.
