- Goal

 - The enhancement of existing infection control curricular components, using Project Firstline resources, in select community and technical college health care programs
 - The creation of content for online training modules to be used in health care education, experiential learning, and workplace settings
- The Faculty Experience:
 - Review/enhance local curricular components/materials (summer 2021)
 - Participate in cohort meetings and community of practice sessions (June-November 2021)
 - Implement enhanced curricular components/materials (fall 2021)
 - Evaluate and revise enhanced curricular components/materials (fall 2021)

Application Process

 - Nursing/LPN/CNA

 - Allied Health (must apply in a specific program/discipline)

- Letters of support
 - Senior Leader
 - Experiential learning site partner
