

The Walmart Brighter Futures 2.0 Project is an effort to move low-income individuals into middle-skill jobs, resulting in higher wages. Armed with 21st century skills, additional education and training, and job search resources, program participants will be more prepared and better able to compete for middle-skill jobs. The goal of the project is to provide low-income adults and older youth the skills necessary to obtain middle-skill jobs enabling them to become financially self-sufficient.

- 2 year grant to provide job training and credentials to low wage, low skilled individuals
- Participants will be screened for eligibility through Center for Student Success. Pathway To Completion coaches.
- Students in ABLE who earn a GED will be a target population
- Students who test into Pathway To Completion criteria will be a target population
- Participants may be connected to Career Services for Job Readiness/ Training through Workforce Development or a partner agency
- Assistance with job placement
