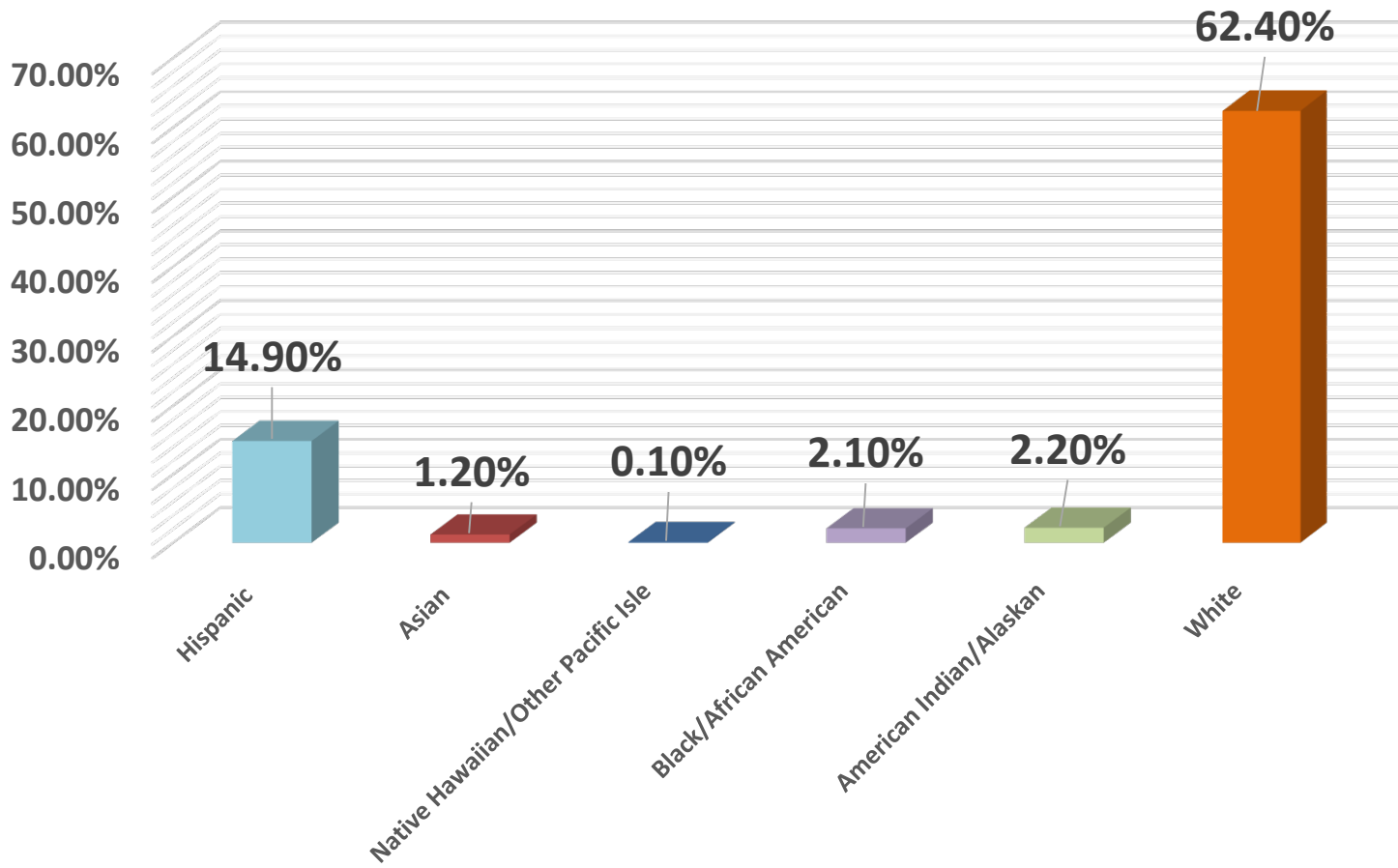

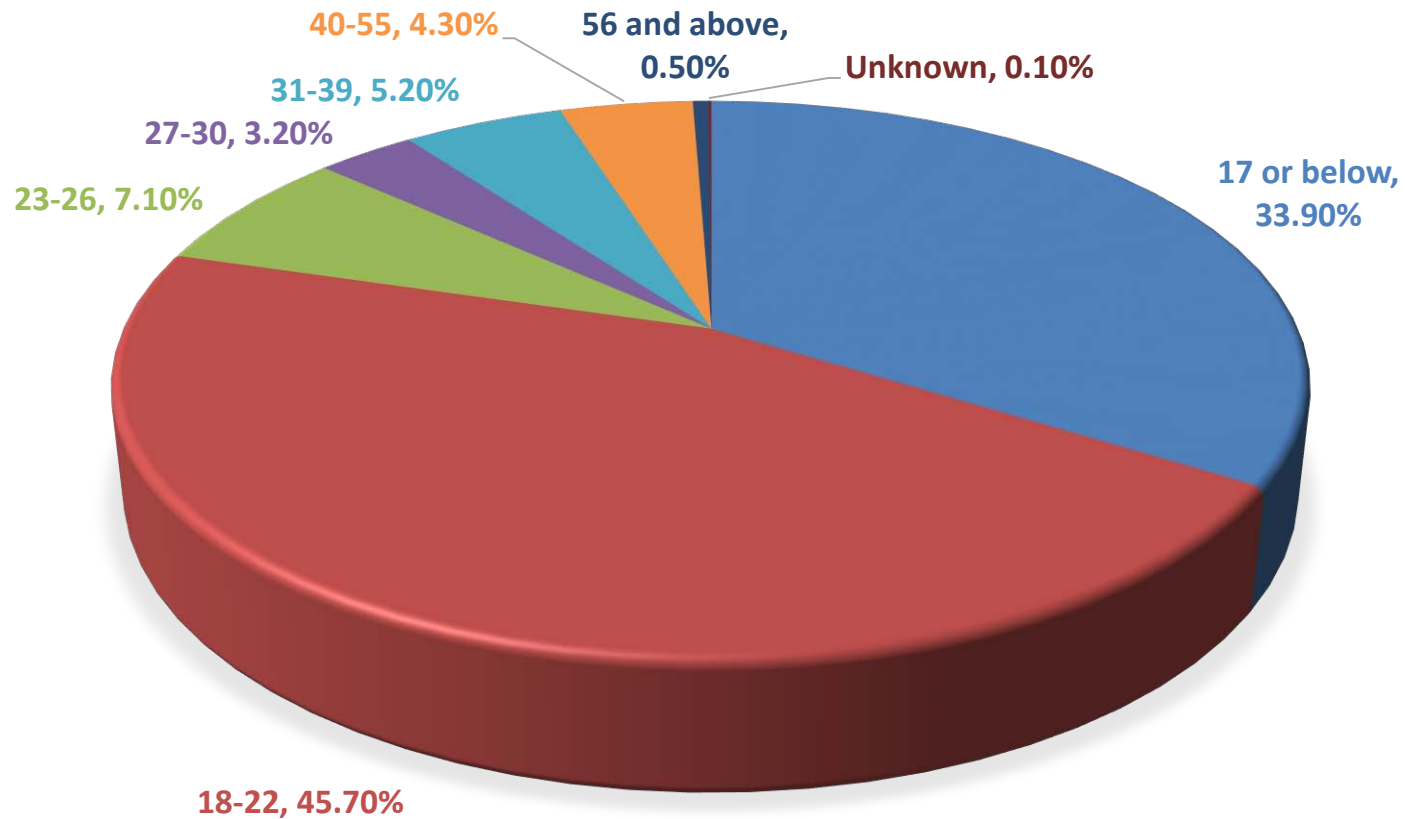

In this linking of academics and action – called service learning – youth investigate, analyze and address community challenges, planting the seed for a lifelong ambition to make the world a better place.”

# Using Service-Learning to Deepen Students' Understanding of Course Content

Service-learning has long been an effective way to help students develop a richer understanding of a subject and also apply what they are learning in a tangible way. Bringle and Hatcher (1996) defined service learning as: “a credit-bearing, educational, experience in which students participate in an organized service activity that meets identified community needs, and reflect on the service activity in such a way as to gain further understanding of course content, a broader appreciation of the discipline, and an enhanced sense of civic responsibility.” Well-designed and implemented service-learning projects can have a significant impact on the undergraduate experience of students

# Volunteers

- Americorp Vista – Coordinator to take phone calls, register participants and volunteers. Marketed the program by visiting Senior Citizen center and Marshalltown library. Advertised in the Marshalltown chamber digest news letter and creative retirement group on Marshalltown Community College campus.
- Marshalltown Community College Foundation helped spread the word around and processed the public donations. Provided giveaways to the participants.
- After the pilot program funding was secured through Wells Fargo Bank \$500.

# Volunteers

- Wells Fargo personnel provided online banking information and handed out door prizes.
- Students from Sociology, Computer Science and TV and broadcasting program volunteered to pre-assess and deliver one on one lesson plan to the participants. Interviews were conducted by students in Sociology class and volunteers.
- Hands on Computer training by Computer Science students and volunteers.
- Computer Hardware Demonstration was conducted.

- TV and Broadcasting students helped with recording the video, editing and uploading the information on youtube channel.

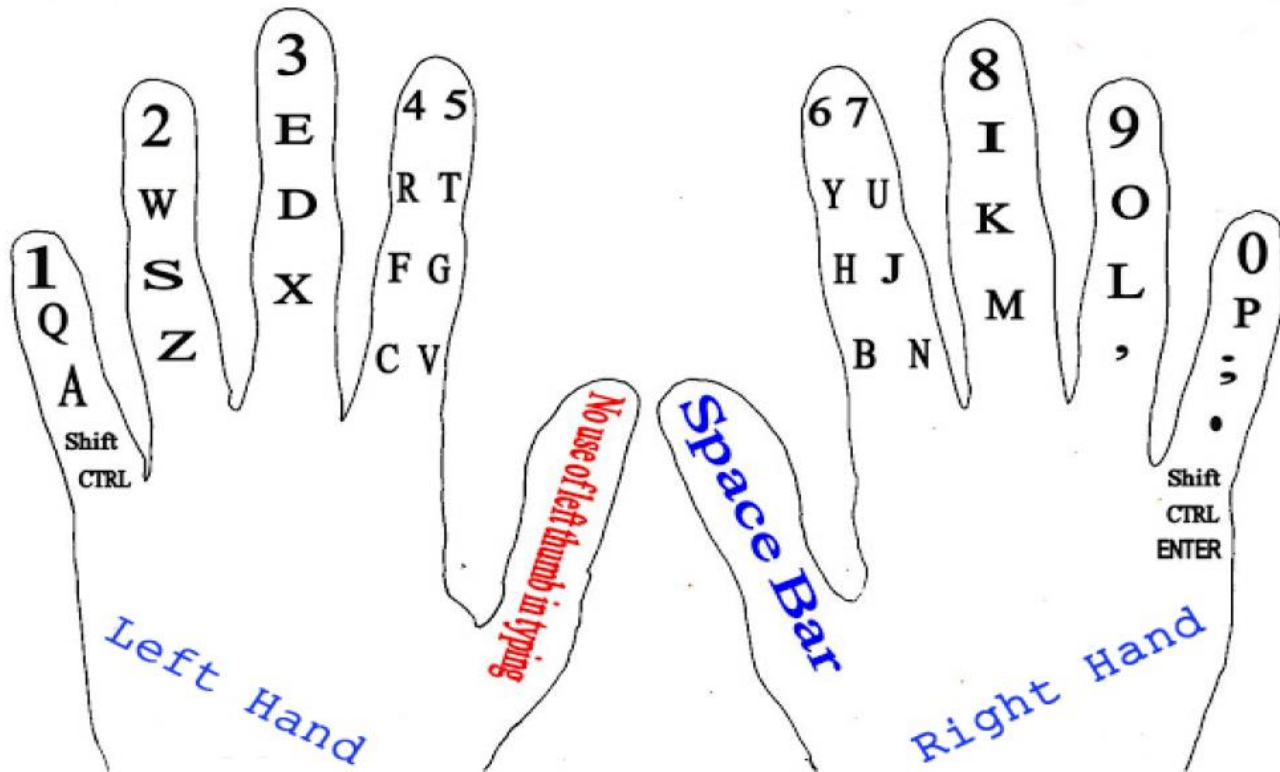
